ANNUAL REPORT 2021 – 22

This year 31 students had appeared in the All India Senior School Certificate Examination of the Central Board of Secondary Education. 13% of the students secured marks above 90%, 29% secured 80% and above marks and 48% of the students secured 70% and above.

31 students had appeared in the All India Secondary School Examination. 16% of the students secured 90% and above marks, 16% of the students secured 80% and above marks and 23% of the students secured 70% and above marks.

ASNA HARIS KOWAPURATH topped the school and stood first in the Commerce stream with an aggregate of 95.2% of marks. HIMA MURSHID was the topper of Science stream with an aggregate of 95% marks.

AYSHA ABDUL KHADER topped the school in All India Senior School Certificate Examination with an aggregate of 94.4 marks. FIDHA RAHMA secured the second highest with 94 marks.
